This correspondence is to: (i) notify you of the upcoming ISSCR members meeting (“Meeting”), and the action upon which the members will vote during the Meeting; and (ii) encourage and facilitate your participation/vote on those action items.

During the upcoming Meeting, eligible voting members may cast their vote to elect the Vice President, three new Directors, and the reappointment of one Director. Meeting attendees can accomplish this by voting in person or selecting to have their vote cast via proxy in the electronic ballot emailed to eligible voters.

The Meeting will be held at **8:30 a.m. on March 20, 2026**, at the UCLA Meyer & Renee Luskin Conference Center, 425 Westwood Plaza, Los Angeles, CA 90095, USA.

If you choose to attend via proxy, ISSCR Past President, Amander Clark (“Amander”), is identified in the electronic ballot emailed to eligible voters as the appointed proxy, and ISSCR Member, Melissa Carpenter (“Melissa”), as the alternate proxy if Amander is unable to attend the Meeting.

Only proxies received on or before March 19, 2026 will be accepted and counted.
